

365 DataScience The enumerate function in Python

Step 1 Create a list of characters

```
# Create a List for which every item is a Letter from the alphabet
alpha_list = list('abcdefghijklmnopqrstuvwxyz')
```

Step 2 Loop through the list using the enumerate() function

```
for count, item in enumerate(alpha_list):
    print(count,item)
```

Step 3 Choose a different starting index

```
# By default, enumerate() starts counting from zero.
# We can change that using the 'start' parameter.
for count, item in enumerate(alpha_list, start = 12):
    print(count,item)
```
